May Program in Review:

At the May Program Marlene Bowman gave a fascinating talk about her history with clay from wheel thrown functional work to her current focus of art created with slabs. As a write up for a Stinking Fish

Tour said "In 1993, after many years of making functional stoneware and classic raku forms, Marlene moved to a small acreage on Vancouver



Island where, inspired by the rocks and forest around her, she discovered the excitement of exploring texture in clay. Her work continues to evolve". Marlene presentation included a demonstration of her slab techniques in which she showed the many found items she uses for texture, the methods she uses to enhance texture with throwing and stretching and how she applies thin deliberately 'crinkled' layers of clay to enhance the visual effect drawn from nature, her inspiration.





One particularly memorable story Marlene told was about the tile installation, which intentionally included broken tiles as part of the intended social commentary of the piece. But the tiles were heavy and Marlene received the dreaded telephone call from the gallery to tell her the piece had fallen from the wall after its installation, but to Marlene's relief. once remounted the



piece was better for the additional breakage caused by the fall.
